**Schlage LiNK™ Upgrades Functionality, Adds iPad® App  
Upgrades enhance remote home management capabilities, iPad app joins apps  
for iPhone, Android and Blackberry**

**CARMEL, Ind., (May 16, 2011)**—Schlage, a business of Ingersoll Rand, which is a world leader in creating and sustaining safe, comfortable and efficient environments, introduced an iPad app for its Schlage LiNK™ System. The remote home management system gives consumers a convenient and affordable way to self-monitor and control access to their homes 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The iPad app, which can be downloaded at the Apple App Store, joins apps already available for iPhone, Android and BlackBerry mobile devices. The company also announced new functionality to the Schlage LiNK System.

“Through this new app, homeowners can use an iPad, from anywhere to remotely perform activities like let a repairman into the house, use a video camera to monitor entryways, turn lights on and off, open and close blinds and even receive a text message indicating that a child has returned home from school,” said Dwight Gibson, vice president and general manager, Connected Home Solutions for Ingersoll Rand.

Other upgrades to the Schlage LiNK System include a feature that takes a snapshot of daily outdoor temperatures (based on ZIP code) to help consumers understand the impact of weather on energy usage. When paired with the Trane Remote Energy Management Thermostat, users can track heating and cooling usage over time in response to weather changes, allowing a homeowner to adjust their heating and cooling systems accordingly and realize real energy and cost savings. These updates are the latest in Schlage’s offering for the Schlage LiNK System aimed at responding to customer’s needs and providing additional value to all for the system’s users. Trane is also an Ingersoll Rand business.

“These new Schlage LiNK upgrades are a series of ongoing enhancements of the system that make it even easier for homeowners to control their home, especially when they’re not physically there,” said Gibson. “When used in conjunction with a Trane Remote Energy Management Thermostat, homeowners can change the home’s temperature settings, all with an eye toward better managing the efficiency of heating and cooling systems.”

Schlage LiNK is a home-management system that gives consumers a convenient and affordable way to self-monitor and control access to a home 24 hours-a-day/seven days-a-week. The basics include a Schlage wireless keypad lock, bridge device, and a light controller. The system is designed around Z-Wave® technology, enabling homeowners to lock and unlock doors and control other Z-Wave-enabled devices—such as lights and cameras—from any computer and most Web-enabled mobile phones.

New users can be up and running quickly. The Schlage LiNK starter kit, which includes the Schlage wireless keypad lock (available in three finishes: bright brass; satin nickel; aged bronze), the bridge (the “brains” of the system) and a light module to remotely control one light, is available online and at select retailers for \$299. Users can also add additional Schlage cameras, additional Z-Wave-enabled light modules and other option to the starter kit to ensure a system that meets their needs. The Trane Remote Energy Management Thermostat is also available online and at major retailers for around \$149. After an initial free trial period, Schlage LiNK requires an \$8.99 monthly subscription fee. There are no long-term contracts or cancellation fees.

In addition to being available online and at retail locations, Schlage and Lennar, one of the nation’s leading home builders in the US, are working together to offer Schlage LiNK standard in most new Lennar communities as part of Lennar’s “Everything’s Included” program, which offers Schlage LiNK, Schlage’s wireless lock, camera, light module and Trane Thermostat installed in the home.
